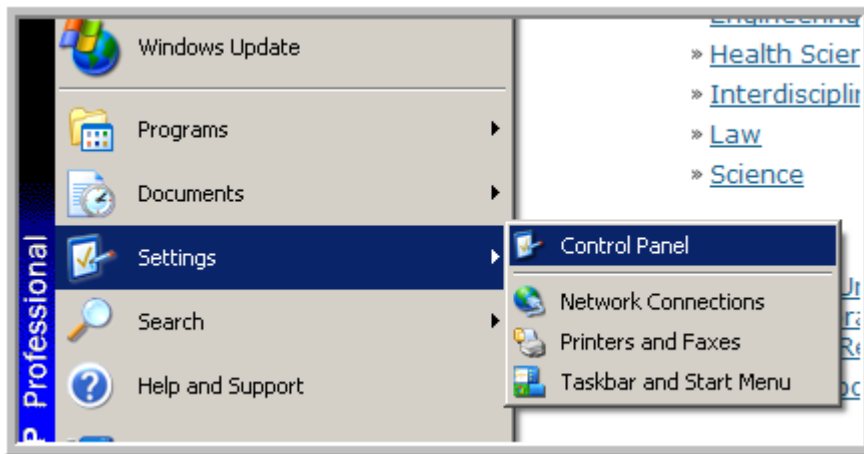


Configuring Internet Explorer & Firefox to Export Ovid Databases into EndNote

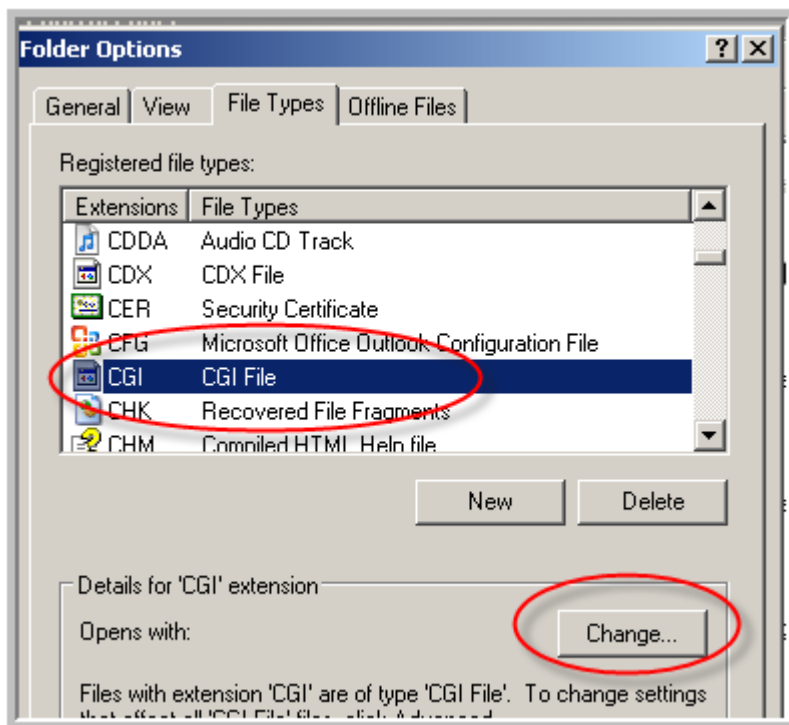
The following are instructions for how to configure Internet Explorer and Firefox so that references can be direct exported into EndNote from Ovid databases.

In Internet Explorer

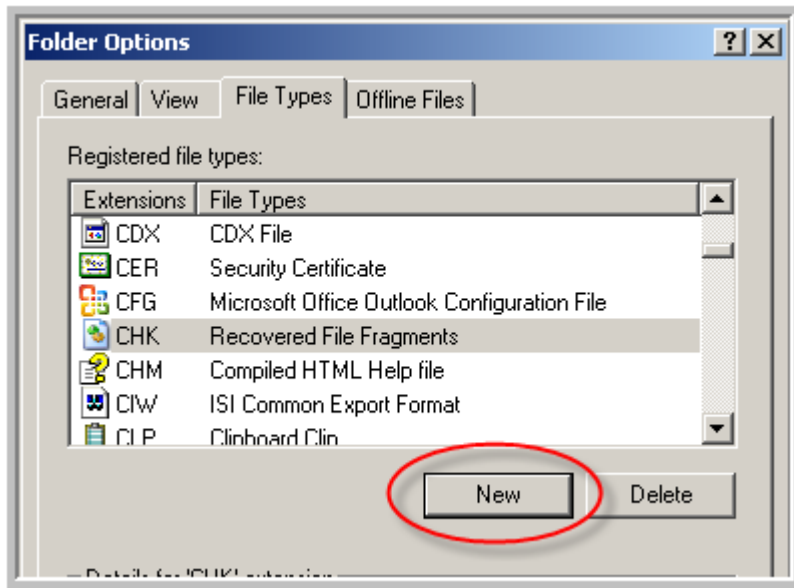
1. Click on **Start** button (lower left hand corner of desktop) and select **Settings/Control Panel**.



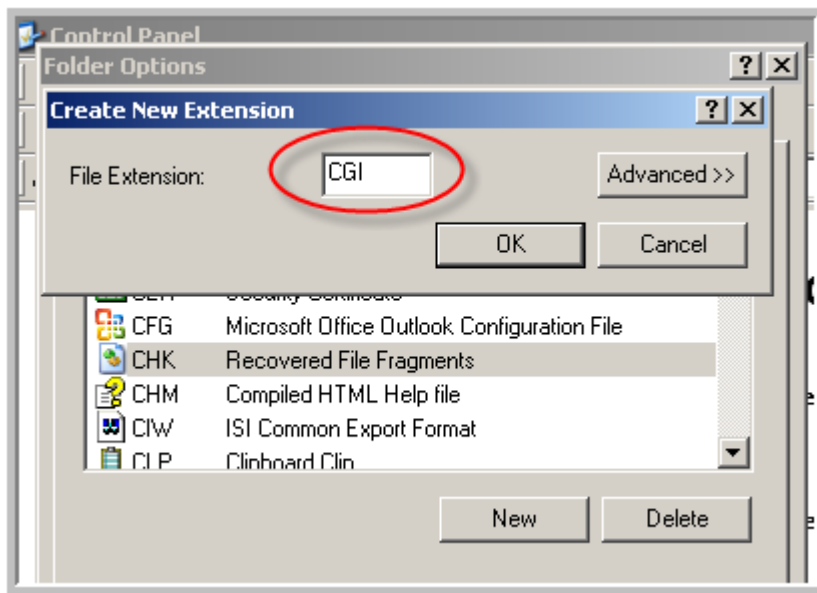
2. At the Control Panel, select **Tools/Folder Options/File Types**. Scroll the list of extensions that will appear. If you see, **CGI** on the list, select that and click on the **Change** button. See Steps 5 through 7 below to continue.



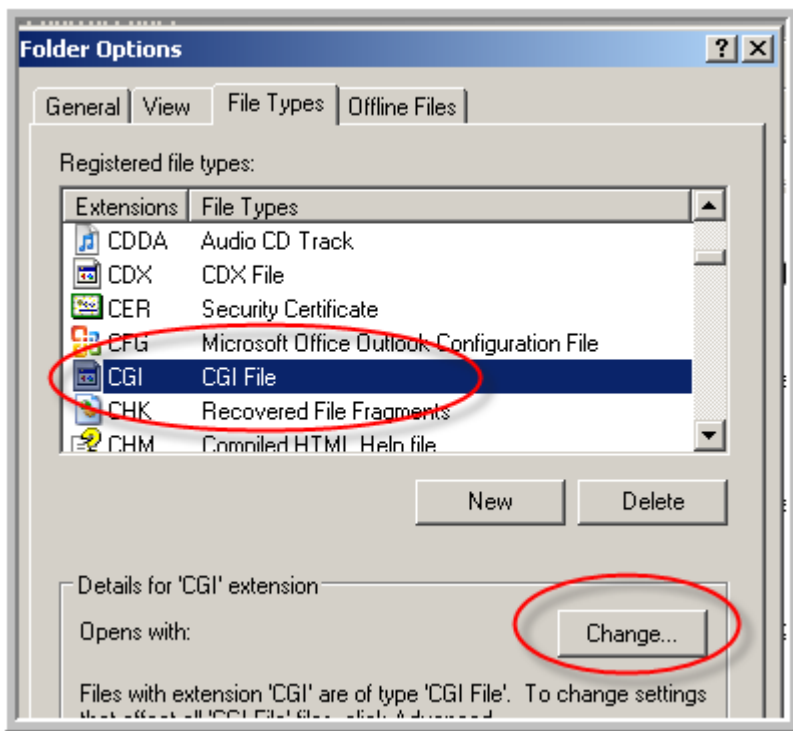
3. If the CGI extension is not listed, click on the **New** button.



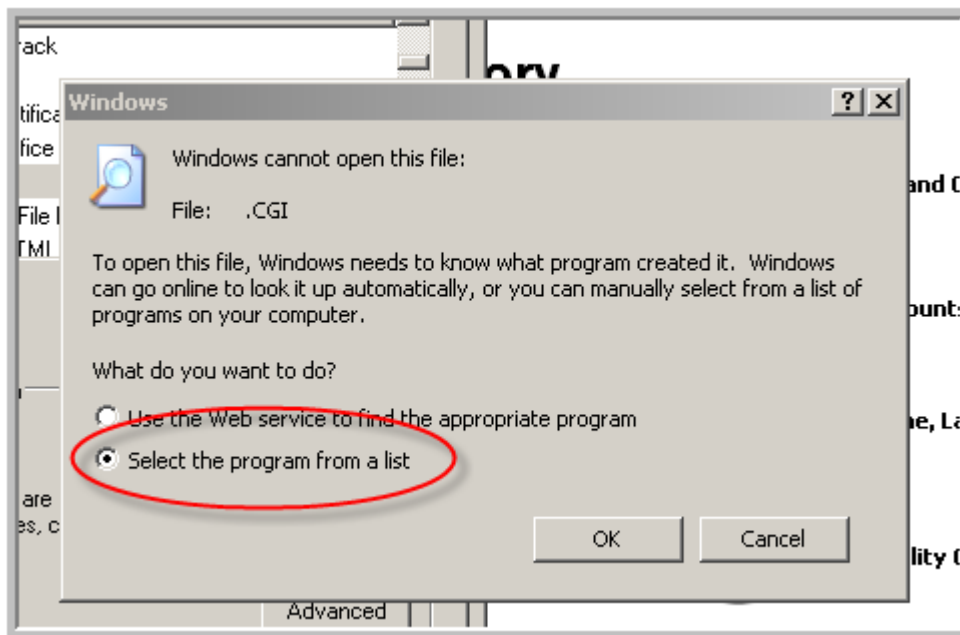
4. Enter **CGI** in the file extension box and click on **OK**.



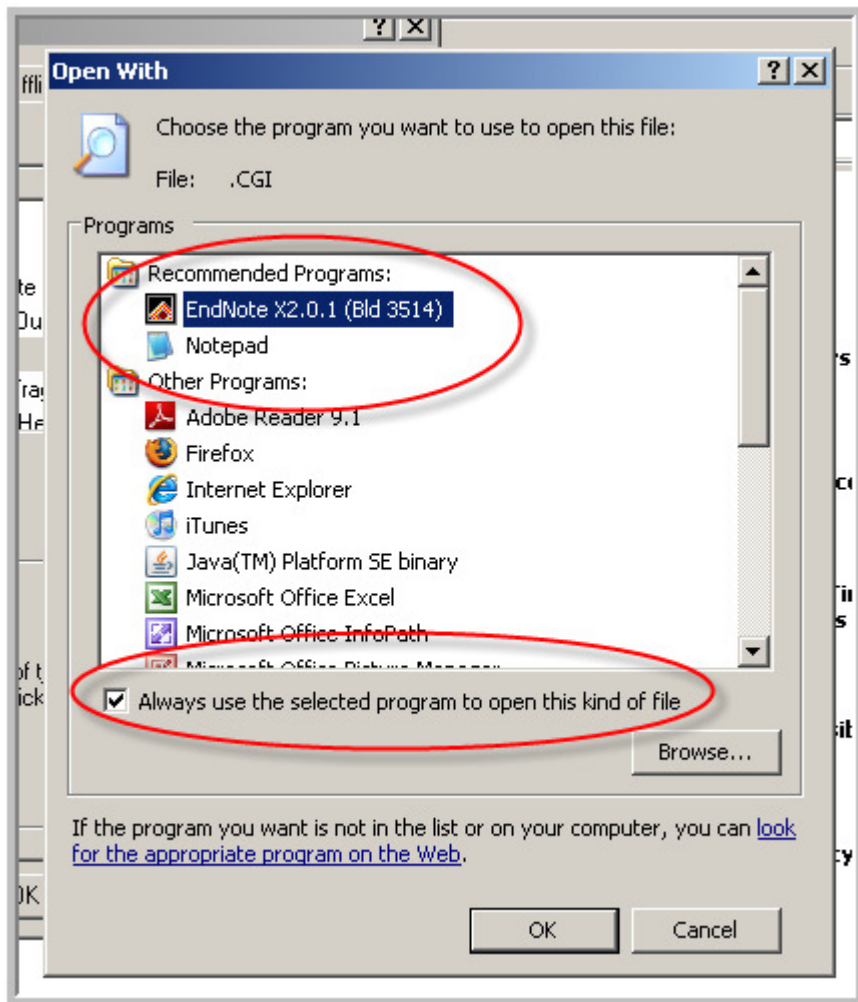
5. After adding the CGI extension to the list, close the *Folder Options* panel and re-open **Tools/Folder Options/File Types**. Locate CGI from the list and click on **Change**.



6. Select **Select the program from a list** and click on **OK**.

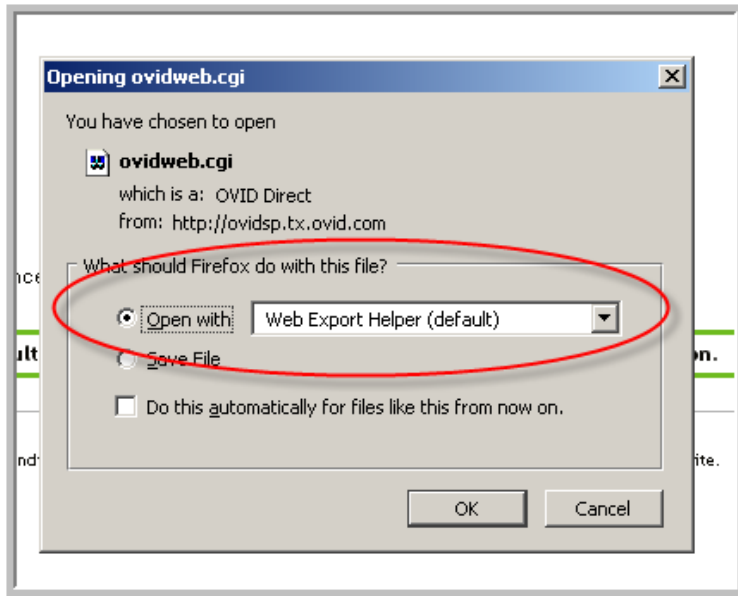


7. Find and select EndNote from the list of programs. Select **Always use the selected program to open this kind of file** and click on **OK**.

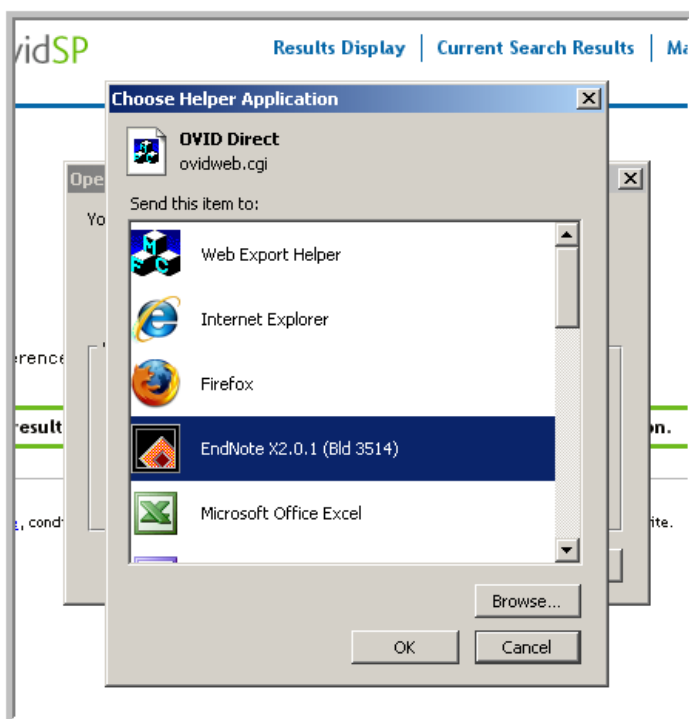


In Firefox

1. If you see the following dialogue when you attempt to use Direct Export from an Ovid database, you must configure Firefox to recognize the format in which Ovid exports information (ovidweb.cgi) :



2. To configure Firefox, open the pull-down menu. If EndNote isn't listed in the pull-down menu, select **Other** and select EndNote from the screen that appears (as below). If EndNote isn't listed, click on **Browse** and find/select **EndNote.exe**.



3. Select **Do this automatically for files like this from now on.** Click on **OK**.
